- III. Approval of Agenda Lee requested the agenda approval. Mr. Davis made a


motion to approve the agenda seconded by Mr. Townsend. It was approved 5-0.

VII. Election Supervisor Report – Mr. McDonald reported that Akyn Bailey has accepted the contract with Floyd County to become the next election supervisor subject to approval by the County Commissioners on their September 27th meeting. She plans to begin work on October 3rd. He gave an update on the preparations for the November 8 election. Ballots and all supplies are in place and ready. UOCOVA and absentee ballots are being processed in preparation for shipping. So far there have been 831 requests for absentee ballots. Poll pads are being replaced by the Secretary of State's office and all other equipment is ready for L&A testing which will begin October 3. Akyn will do that for us, saving the County over \$14,000. He then discussed the election schedule and locations. Early voting will again take place at the election center and the Anthony Center. We will be adding BMDs to the larger

voting precincts to reduce the wait time for voters. There will be an additional team to deliver the voting equipment to allow more time for the managers to set up. Absentee and UOCOVA ballots will be scanned on November 3rd and 4th and tabulated on election day after 7:00PM. All training for Poll Workers is scheduled and the political parties have been notified to train their poll watchers and to notify elections of their names.
